Class 5 - Ewe under 1 ½ years

Class 7- Ewe lamb born after 1st April

POLL DORSET

Class 8 – **The Lindsay Wright Memorial class PDCW Region** Novice ram under 1½ years shorn. (Open to Horns) *To be prepared & handled by owner*

Class 9 - Ram over 1½ years old shorn.

Class 10- **Kentish Downs Trophy** Performance ram under 1½ yrs old.

Machine shorn not more than 28 days and no less than 14 days prior to judging. Birth dates must be included, rams will be scanned for fat depth and eye muscle upon arrival, points will be allocated for these traits as well as the official allocating points for breed type.

Cannot be drawn from other classes

- Class 11 - **Brien Freebairn Memorial Trophy**. Ram under 1½ years old.
- Class 12 - **Gererdan Trophy** – Ram under 1 ½ years shorn. Not more than 2cms wool.
- Class 13-**Optamax** Pair Rams under 1½ years shorn. Not more than 2cms wool.
- Class 14 -**Balmoral Trophy** – Ram under 1 ½ years old. Machine shorn not more than 28 days and no less than 14 days prior to judging. STRICTLY NO TRIMMING. (OM)

The trophy was presented by WS Martin & Son and an investment is held by the NSW State Committee. The trophy to the value of the accrued interest shall be awarded to the exhibitor who gains 1st in the class on 3 occasions not necessarily in succession, after which it shall recommence.

- Class 16 - **Allan Gray & Co** Milk Tooth ram, born after 1st June shorn, not more than 2cm wool
- Class 17 - Milk tooth ram dropped after 1st August, woolly
- Class 18 - **Agricon Rural Marketing Trophy** Milk tooth ram, shorn not more than 2cm wool and dropped after the 1st August, open to horns.
- Class 19 – **Boyd Metalworks** Pair of Rams Milk teeth, shorn no more than 2cm wool and dropped after the 1st August
- Class 20 - **Symbah Trophy**, Ram Lamb dropped after the 1st April.

Class 26 – **Optamax** Milk tooth Ewe, shorn, not more than 2cm born after 1st August

Class 27 –**Cowra Shire Council** Ewe shorn over 1 ½ years with lamb at foot. Both to be judged.

Class 28 - **Claremont Trophy** Ewe lamb dropped after 1st April
