MEASURING STEWARD: Measuring available on request, or in the event of a dispute.

ENTRY FEES: \$2.00 for all events (coin entry) unless otherwise specified.

No refunds, except at the discretion of the Ringmaster and/or Chief Steward.

All protests must be lodged in writing with the Chief Steward, together with a \$20 deposit within one (1) hour of the event.

All exhibitors must adhere to the Cowra Show Society General Regulations. Breaches will incur penalties.

Stewards reserve the right to order a blood/urine sample to be taken from any horse competing in the horse sections.

Judging will not normally be held up waiting for competitors from other rings. Therefore each competitor must decide on the priorities well in advance. Two calls only will be made to the marshalling yard, one warning call and a final call for each ring. No competitor is permitted to enter the ring once judging commences.

- **“District Events”** means a 60km radius from Cowra.
- **“Novice Events”** means a horse not yet won a First Prize in an equivalent event at another show.
- **“Intermediate Events”** mean a horse that has not yet been placed in their individual events at a Royal Show.
- **Horses awarded Champion &/or Reserve Champ award** in 1st Ring are NOT eligible to compete in the 2nd Ring.
- **Horses must either compete in the Show Hunter or the Open rings.. they may NOT compete in both.**
- Breed Class horses must be registered with their respective societies. Classification/ Registration papers must be available on request by a steward.
- Showjumpers must have their EFA registration papers to enter any competitions.
- Stallions cannot compete under saddle unless in Breed Classes, or otherwise specified.
- All Stallions must be led with a bit, and must be handled by a person 18yrs or over.
- Any exhibitor or their representative must not be seen talking to a judge about their exhibits prior to the completion of the section that they are competing in. Doing so will render their exhibits liable to disqualification.
- No horses are permitted in the side-road camping area – NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Horse Stalls must be booked on the enclosed form and directed to the Show Secretary.
- Own bedding required.
- Lunch breaks will be advised to competitors as soon as soon as practical.
- Approved Safety Helmets must be worn at all times whilst mounted and straps fastened.
- Outside assistance to any competitor by word, radio and or other method will not be permitted.
- Use of radio controlled devices by competitors or spectators is banned for the duration of the show unless specifically authorised by the executives of the society.
- Classes will only be split if 3 or more horses remain in EACH division.
- **WORKING SHOW HUNTER CONDITIONS: (competitors must remain in the ring during judging)** The working hunter class is assessed in three separate phases: 1- Jumping phase, 2 - ride phase and 3 – a conformation phase. Scores from all three sections are added together to decide the winner and placegetters. Equipment: Turnout similar to show hunter classes, however an all purpose saddle may be used. Whips maximum length 75cm excluding thong/lash. No bearing/side/running reins permitted. Protective boots permitted for jumping phase ONLY. All competitors to wear approved safety helmet with chin strap. No other change of saddlery is allowed between phases except removal of boots. Allocation of marks (Maximum): Jumping – 40 points, Workout on flat (incl movement/manners/ etc) - 30 points, Conformation – 30 points. Total 100 points.

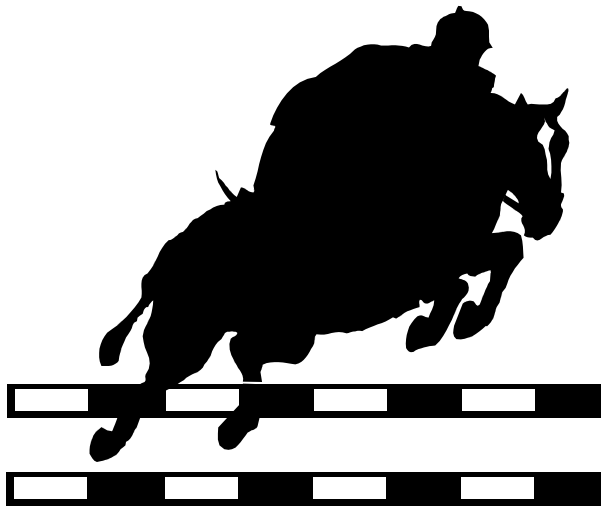
