Regulations See also General Regulations
Ovine Johne's Disease Declaration must be provided.
All sheep will be catered for including sheep cleared under Market Assurance.
Sheep Ovine Brucellosis Test.
Rams will only be accepted from an accredited flock. Accreditation number must be entered on entry form. A local exhibitor is one whose property is within 50 kms of Cowra Showground.
Sheep exhibited as bred by exhibitor must have breeder's registered tattoo or earmark.
Exhibitors of sheep must at the time of entry, state name of breeder if known.
All sheep shall be eligible to compete for Champion prize and no further entry will be required in Champion classes.
The judges shall have the power to disqualify and mark disqualified any exhibit which in their opinion does not comply with the regulations, and shall enter same in their books. Judges NEED NOT GIVE A REASON.
In the event of any protest or disqualification being upheld, the next award in order, to take the prize.
Exhibitors must be the bona fide owners for at least one month prior to the Show.
Stud sheep are to carry not less than 6 month's wool unless otherwise specified and not more than 12 months.
All sheep under one and a half years must not show more than two teeth at time of exhibition.
Stock feed will not be supplied. Bedding for stock will be supplied.
Ribbons must not be moved earlier than 5.00 pm on Show day.
Ribbons are the responsibility of the exhibitor once they are placed in the pens.
In the event of a tie, the winner of the greatest number of first prizes is to have precedence.

Trophies can not be collected until 4 pm on day of exhibition.

Entry fee \$3 per entry

Entries close on Monday 13th September.

All exhibits must be penned by 8.30 am Wednesday 15th September 2010.

All sheep are to remain in pens until 5.00pm on Wednesday.

Judging

All sheep will be shown on Wednesday, 15th September, 2010

Judging will commence at 10 am.

Merino Breeders' section

Classes 1 to 25 must be bred by exhibitor.

All sheep under one and a half years are not to have more than two teeth.

Sheep over one and a half and under two and a half years are not eligible if showing 6 teeth.
