ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND REGULATIONS

- Handler age as of 1st October 2025
- Animal handler waivers **MUST** be signed prior to competing (available on the day)
- All dogs take turns at jumping in each round. At the end of each round, the height will be increased. All dogs that made the previous height jump in the next round.
- Each dog is allowed three attempts at each height and will be disqualified if unsuccessful on the third attempt.
- In the event of two dogs jumping the same height, the winner will be the dog that took the least amount of attempts at the winning jump.
- The judges decision is final.

DOG HIGH JUMP

- The handler can encourage the dog over by vocal or visual command but not by pushing or pulling the dog over.
- **DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES WHEN NOT COMPETING IN THE HIGH JUMP.**

1. Highest Dog Jump – Open
