2022 Classes

DORSET HORNS

- Class 1 Ram under 1½ years woolly
- Class 2 Ram under 1½ years shorn not more than 2cm
- Class 3 Ram under 1½ years machine shorn
- Class 4 Milk tooth ram woolly dropped after 1st August
- Class 5 Milk tooth ram shorn dropped after 1st August (OM) not more than 2cm
- Class 6 Ram lamb dropped after 1st April

Champion Ram

Reserve Champion Ram

- Class 7 Ewe under 1½ years woolly
- Class 8 Ewe under 1½ years shorn
- Class 9 Milk tooth ewe any length wool, dropped after 1st August
- Class 10 Ewe lamb born after 1st April

Champion Ewe

Reserve Champion Ewe

- Class 11 Group of 1 ram and 2 ewes under 1 ½ years – any wool

SCHOOLS

- Class 12 1 ram up to 2cm wool under 1 1/2 years
- Class 13 Pair rams, up to 2cm wool under 1 1/2 years
- Class 14 Ewe over 1 ½ years shorn suckling her own offspring
- Class 15 1 ewe up to 2cm wool under 1 1/2 years
- Class 16 Pair ewes, up to 2cm wool under 1 1/2 years

****All school classes open to Poll Dorset and Dorset Horns.

Schools are encouraged to enter open classes.

Novice Rams

- Class 17 Novice ram lamb born after 1st April (open to horns)
- Class 18 **The Lindsay Wright Memorial Class PDCW Region** Novice ram under 1½ years shorn (open to Horns) *to be prepared and handled by exhibitors.*

Rams

Senior

- Class 19 Restricted Class:
Ram under 1 ½ years shorn. Not more than 2cm wool. To be eligible studs must have no more than 100 ewes
- Class 20 Lambplan Ram under 1 ½ years, shorn.
Born on or after 1st April in the year prior to the Show.
The Office to be notified of entry tag numbers, no later than 1st June.
Lambplan Assessment:
TCP Index the difference between the highest and lowest index will be doubled and allocated to the judge for selective judging points. These points will be added to the individual entrant's index to give a total score.
- Class 21 Lambplan Pair
Born on or after 1st April in the year prior to the Show.
The Office to be notified of entry tag numbers, no later than 1st June.
Lambplan Assessment:
TCP Index the difference between the highest and lowest index will be doubled and allocated to the judge for selective judging points. These points will be added to the individual entrant's index to give a total score.
- Class 22 Ram over 1 1/2 years shorn not to exceed 2cms of wool
- Class 23 Performance ram under 1½ years old. Machine shorn not more than 28 days and not less than 7 days prior to judging. Birth dates must be included, April May drop. Rams will be scanned for fat depth and eye muscle upon arrival. Points will be allocated for these traits as well as the official allocating points for breed type. Cannot be drawn from other classes.
- Class 24 **Brien Freebairn Memorial Trophy** Ram under 1½ years old woolly
- Class 25 **Gererdan Trophy Ram** under 1½ years shorn. Not more than 2 cm wool
- Class 26 **Balmoral Trophy** Ram under 1½ years old. Machine shorn not more than 28 days and no less than 7 days prior to judging. STRICTLY NO TRIMMING (OM)
The trophy was presented by WS Martin & Son and an investment is held by the NSW State Committee. The trophy to the value of the accrued interest shall be awarded to the exhibitor who gains first in the class on three occasions, not necessarily in succession, after which it shall recommence.
- Class 27 Pair rams under 1½ years shorn. Not more than 2 cm wool

Class 28 Pair rams under 1½ years old. Machine shorn not more than 28 days and not less than 7 days prior to judging. STRICTLY NO TRIMMIN

Sheep entered in one class, cannot be entered in another class, unless it is a group class.

Intermediate Rams

Class 29 Performance Ram Born on or after 1st June 2021 Milk tooth. Machine shorn not more than 28 days and not less than 7 days prior to judging. Birth dates must be included, drop. Rams will be scanned for fat depth and eye muscle upon arrival. Points will be allocated for these traits as well as the official allocating points for breed type. Cannot be drawn from other classes.

Class 30 Ram born on or after 1st June 2021, Milk tooth shorn, not more than 2 cm wool

Class 31 Ram, born on or after 1st June 2021 Milk Tooth, bare shorn. Machine shorn not more than 28 days and no less than 7 days prior to judging, no trimming.

Class 32 Pair of rams, born on or after 1st June 2021, Milk Took up to 2cm wool.

Sheep entered in one class, cannot be entered in another class, unless it is a group class.

Junior / Spring Drop Rams

Class 33 Performance ram dropped on or after 1st August 2021, Machine shorn not more than 28 days and not less than 7 days prior to judging. Birth dates must be included. Rams will be scanned for fat depth and eye muscle upon arrival. Points will be allocated for these traits as well as the official allocating points for breed type. Cannot be drawn from other classes.

Class 34 Ram woolly dropped on or after or on 1 August 2021.

Class 35 Ram, shorn, not more than 2 cm wool and dropped on or after 1st August.2021

Class 36 Pair of rams, shorn, no more than 2 cm wool and dropped on or after 1st August 2021.

Class 37 **Symbah Trophy** Ram lamb dropped after 1st April 2022.

- Class 41 Restricted Class: Ewe under 1 ½ years shorn. Not more than 2cm wool. To be eligible studs must have no more than 100 ewes.
- Class 42 Woolly Ewe under 1½ years
- Class 43 **Springwaters Trophy** Ewe under 1½ years shorn, not more than 2 cm wool
- Class 44 Ewe under 1½ years, machine shorn not more than 28 days prior and not less than 14 days before judging. STRICTLY NO TRIMMING
- Class 45 Pair ewes under 1½ years, machine shorn, not more than 28 days prior and not less than 14 days before judging. STRICTLY NO TRIMMING
- Class 46 Milk tooth ewe, shorn, not more than 2 cm, born after 1st August
- Class 47 **Claremont Trophy** Ewe lamb dropped on or after 1st April 2022.
