CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All entries must clearly state name, address and Class on the back.
2. A limit of two (2) entries per section.
3. Collect entries from Pavilion between 10am and 12pm Sunday 18th & between 10am - 3pm Tuesday 20th & Wednesday 21st October 2026
4. All work must be the work of the exhibitor. Commercial processing is acceptable.
5. Photographs will not be accepted if they have previously been entered at the Cowra Show. Entries must have been shot and printed in the 12 months prior to the Show.
6. The judge's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into. Class 8 will be judged by the Young Woman of the Year candidates.
7. All possible care will be taken of entries, but no responsibility is accepted by the Cowra Show Society Inc. for any loss or damage during the exhibition, storage or transit.
8. If any class attracts less than five (5) entries, then entries may be put in another class by the Chief Steward.
9. The work is hung at the Chief Steward's discretion.
10. (a) Entries in ALL Sections must be mounted on CARDBOARD only.

(b) All prints must be clearly labelled on the back with the entrant's name, address and section.

(c) Maximum mount size is 20 x 25cm.
