- Multiple entries permitted.
- Embellishments permitted, providing there is no piercing or cutting of the pumpkin. Any pumpkins pierced or cut into will not be accepted for entry.
- Pumpkins may be grown or bought by the exhibitor.
- Entries can be collected from 12 noon Sunday 19th October 2025.
- Any pumpkins not collected by 4pm Wednesday 22nd October 2025 will be thrown out.

6. Celebrity look-alike pumpkin decorated by exhibitor under 12 years
7. Celebrity look-alike pumpkin decorated by exhibitor over 18 years
