Entry details:

1. All pieces must be originals by the artist, created in the last 36 months, and not have been shown at the Cowra Spring Show previously.
2. All entries must have the artist's name, class number, title, sale price (or, if not for sale – NFS), artist contact details on the back, clearly legible.
3. Paintings without adequate hanging wire/cord/rings may not be hung or judged.
4. All entries must be delivered to the Cowra Spring Show secretary by Thursday 9th October, 3pm. Show office hours are Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, 10am – 3pm, or by appointment.
5. Entry fees must be paid to the Secretary at the same time as delivering the artworks.
6. The Cowra Show Society will retain a 20% commission on all artworks sold during the Show. The winning entry in the Landscape (Section 4) or Still life (Section 5) may be selected to be displayed at Central West Credit Union for one month following the Spring Show.
7. All artworks must remain on display for the full duration of the Cocktail Party and Cowra Spring Show.
8. The Cowra Spring Show takes all care and no responsibility for the entries.
9. Winners will be announced at the Cocktail Party to be held on Saturday 11th October, from 6pm. Artists and their partners are invited to attend.
10. Entries will be available for collection from the Pavilion on Sunday 19th October between 10am – 12pm, or during Show Office hours the following week, and must be collected by Tuesday 28th October or will be disposed of unless prior arrangements have been made.
