

Cowra Show Prime Lamb Hoof Competition

Entry Fee: \$20 per pen of 3 lambs.

Payment can be made to Cowra Show Society, BSB: 032 820 Acc: 280 323. Ref: 'PRIMELAMB last name'. Reference MUST be provided otherwise payment may not be reconciled against entries.

Receipt of payment MUST accompany entries.

Entries close: Thursday 14th October 2026 5pm.

Lambs may arrive from 7am to 10am Saturday 17th October 2026.

Lambs MUST be penned by 10am.

Judging will commence at 12pm Saturday 17th October 2026.

Conditions of Entry:

- Lambs must be vendor bred or owned for a minimum of 6 weeks, and must be new season lambs.
- Lambs must not be within a WHP and/or an ESI.
- All entries must be accompanied by an accredited NVD and National Sheep Health Statement.
- All entries will be sold to processors on completion of the competition.
- All entries must include the following documentation, or will not be accepted: Entry Form, Accredited National Vendor Declaration, National Sheep Health Statement and Waiver Forms. All documentation must be fully completed and signed.

- No stock shall be unloaded without completed NVD and National Sheep Health Statement. Exhibitors showing infected sheep may be liable to fines, as per the government regulations. Any health concerns must be brought to the immediate attention of the chief stewards, and animals deemed unwell will be referred to the District Veterinarian, or Cowra Show Society Veterinarian.
- All entries must be tagged with a compliant electronic NLIS ear tag.
- Vehicles and trailers must be thoroughly cleaned & washed prior to loading sheep for the show.
- First Place winners will be automatically entered into the Grand Champion class.
- Lambs will be weighed on arrival and allocated to corresponding class. Exhibitors will be paid on the average weight of their relevant class at hook rate at the time of processing.
- Lamb payments will be paid to all entrants by direct deposit within 10 business days as per the settling agent's terms. All entrants must supply bank details with entries otherwise payments may not be processed. The Cowra Show Society & settling agent take no responsibility for any incorrect bank details provided.
- All entries will be sold to processors on completion of the competition. Commission will be charged on settlement, which will then be donated back to Cowra Show Society by settling agent.

1. Trade Lambs

Entry Fee: \$20 per pen of 3 lambs

Eligible lambs must be 52kg liveweight or under. Lambs must be new season and not shorn.

1st Place - \$200 2nd Place - \$100

2. Export Lambs

Entry Fee: \$20 per pen of 3 lambs.

Eligible lambs must be over 52kg liveweight. Lambs must new season and not shorn.

1st Place - \$200 2nd Place - \$100

3. Shorn Lambs

Entry Fee: \$20 per pen of 3 lambs

All shorn lambs are eligible. Must be new season. Any weight.

1st Place - \$200 2nd Place - \$100

4. Grand Champion Pen of Three Lambs

All 1st placed lambs are eligible.
